Doggy Daycare General Information and Policies

Our daycare program strives to provide a fun, healthy, safe, stimulating environment for your dog. To help us provide this type of environment, we ask that all clients comply with the following requirements:

AGE: All dogs must be 12 weeks or older to play in daycare. All dogs over the age of 7 months must be spayed or neutered.

TREATS & TRAINING: Part of your dog's success in our daycare relies on our ability to reward good behavior as well as disagree with unwanted behaviors. Therefore, we use praise as well as very small training treats to teach good doggy manners. If your dog has any food allergies, notify staff immediately upon dropping off.

VACCINATIONS: All dogs must be current on their vaccines. We require Rabies (1yr or 3 yr), Distemper Combo (1yr or 3 yr), Leptospirosis (if on a 3 yr Distemper protocol), Bordetella (done every 6 months), Canine Influenza vaccination, a negative fecal (done every 6 months), and a negative heartworm test yearly.

FEES: We offer full day daycare at reasonable rates. We also offer packages that can be used over a 6 month period. Please call or check out our website for more details. Payment for daycare is due in advance or at time of drop off.

LATE CHARGES: A late fee of \$5.00 per 5 minutes will be applied starting at the end of business hours. Any dog not picked up after 30 minutes will be placed in boarding and the late fee plus 1 night of boarding will be charged. Please call if you feel that you will not be able to pick up your pet from daycare on time.

RESERVATIONS: Reservations are required for daycare. We ask that you call at least 24 hours in advance to make reservations for daycare.

DAYS and HOURS: Daycare hours are Monday through Friday 7:00am to 7:00pm. (Regular business hours are Monday through Friday 7:00am-7:00pm; Saturday 9:00am to

1:00pm Note: Business hours are different than daycare hours.) Daycare activities on Saturday or Sunday are limited to our guests staying overnight in our suites.

ENROLLMENT: To be enrolled in our daycare program, dogs must pass a temperament evaluation. Evaluations are done by appointment only. Call for an appointment today!

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify that their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could jeopardize other guests. There are unavoidable viruses and conditions that we may experience by having a community of dogs together but we will make every effort to keep them to a minimum. If your dog is coughing, has diarrhea, or is displaying any signs of being ill, please notify us prior to bringing your dog to daycare. We also require that all dogs be on flea, tick and heartworm prevention all year long.

BEHAVIOR: Owners will certify that their dogs have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog. Please remember, your dog will be spending time with other dogs and their safety and health are our main concern. If a dog is presenting behaviors that are disruptive to the rest of the group, we may have to take steps to change their behavior. The process could be as simple as separating them from another dog or the group, or maybe taking a break from daycare while training classes are attended. In rare cases, we may ask that your dog not return to our daycare program. This does not mean that your dog isn't able to socialize with other dogs; it may simply mean that this environment isn't good for your dog.

NOTE: We require that your dog wear a regular, properly fitted collar with a quick-release style buckle and that they come to daycare every day on a leash.

INJURIES: Olentangy Premier Pet Care keeps the safety of your pet and the other guests a number one priority. We strive to maintain a controlled environment for all guests but remember, there is an inherent risk in all dog play and Olentangy Premier Pet Care will not be responsible for injuries resulting from attending daycare. If a dog should sustain an injury, we will notify the owner and discuss a course of action for the particular situation.

In event of an emergency, I give Olentangy Premier Pet Care permission to perform life saving medical care, but they must contact me or my emergency contact before doing any other medical care as I may wish to transport my animal elsewhere.

I understand that Olentangy Premier Pet Care requires all dogs in the daycare to be current on all their vaccines, heartworm and flea preventative as well as requiring all dogs to be spayed/neutered. Furthermore I understand that by doing this, Olentangy Premier Pet Care has taken reasonable steps to ensure that all dogs present in daycare behave well in groups. Any dog demonstrating behavior that is aggressive toward other animals or staff will not be allowed to return to daycare.

Furthermore, I understand that Olentangy Premier Pet Care may have vaccine requirements that differ from personal veterinary recommendations. I understand that Olentangy Premier Pet Care based their requirements on a vaccine study done by the American Veterinary Medicine Association and will not be altered under any situation. The vaccine requirements are as follows: Rabies vaccine every 1 or 3 years depending on the age of the dog, Distemper Combo yearly, and Bordetella vaccine every 6 months. Olentangy Premier Pet Care also requires a yearly negative heartworm test for dogs over 1 year of age and a negative fecal every 6 months.

_____ I understand that to continue coming to daycare, my dog will need a fecal test with a negative result every 6 months.
